The Story of Christian Worship

This is an introduction to the history of Christian worship, from New Testament times to the present day.

The four sessions concentrate on periods in history which have seen the greatest worship changes taking place:

- The New Testament, 1st-2nd century
- The Early Church, 3rd-5th century
- The Reformation, 15th-17th century
- Modern times, 20th-21st century.

Each session will be illustrated and accompanied by examples of worship texts from the period, and will give a sense of where our own worship comes from and why we do many of the things we do in church.

St Barnabas Church can be accessed by car via Ferniehill Road and there are extensive parking facilities. There are regular buses to Gilmerton Road - nos 3, 3a, 8 and 29 from North Bridge and there is disabled access and a loop system
