FLOWER FESTIVAL – 26, 27 & 28 JUNE

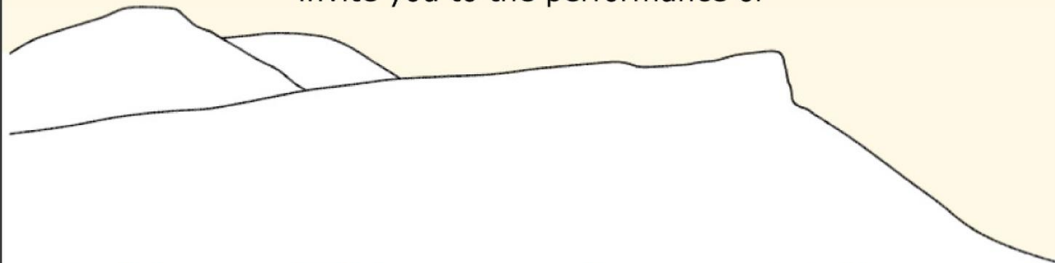
