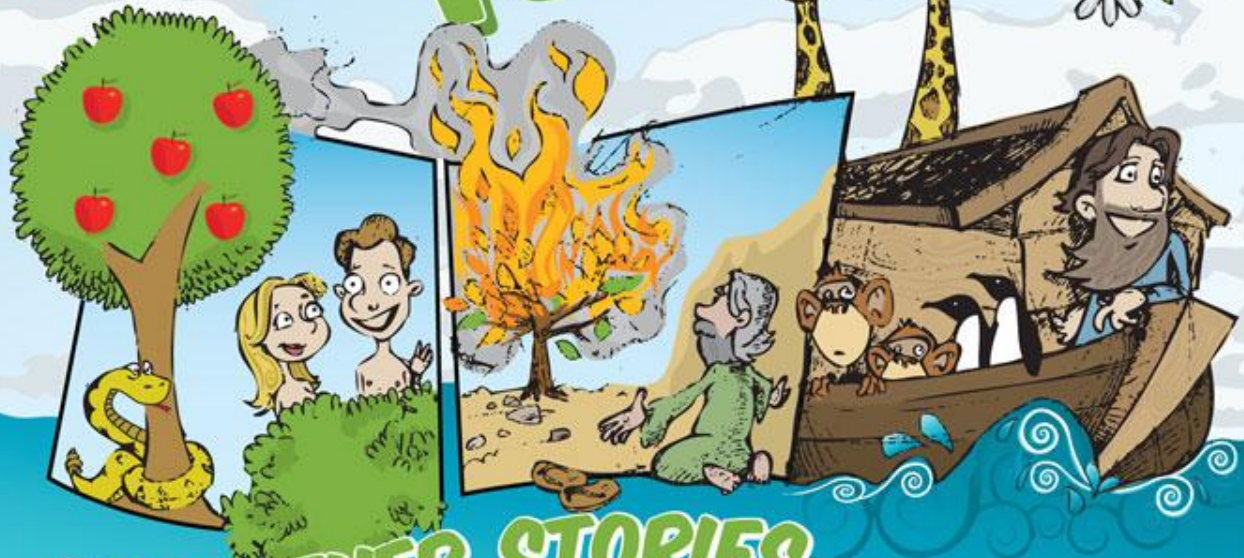
### **St James' Day Pilgrim Celebration At Christ Church Holy Corner**
